Inflation trends in the regions

November 2021

Annual inflation in November 2021 was 8.7% (in October - 8.9%). Prices for food increased by 10.9% (in October - 11.3%), for non-food - by 8.3% (in October - 7.8%), for paid services - by 6.4% (in October - 6.9%).

The slowdown of annual inflation was observed in 11 regions, the acceleration - in 4 regions, in 2 regions the growth rate remained unchanged. The most noticeable slowdown of growth rate was noted in Karagandy (from 9.6% in October to 8.9% in November) and Atyrau (from 9.2% to 8.5%) regions. The highest acceleration took place in East Kazakhstan region (from 8.8% to 9.2%). Annual inflation was higher than the national level in 10 regions, among which the largest value was noted in Mangystau and East Kazakhstan regions (9.4% and 9.2%, respectively).

Annual growth of food products price was higher than the national level (10.9%) in Mangystau (12.2%), Akmola (11.7%), Kyzylorda (11.3%), Aktobe (11.2%), Atyrau (11.1%), also Pavlodar, North Kazakhstan, Turkistan, East Kazakhstan regions and Almaty city (11.0%).

Prices for non-food products above the country level (8.3%) increased in Karagandy (9.3%), Akmola (9.2%), Aktobe (9.2%), Pavlodar (8.8%), East Kazakhstan (8.8%) and North Kazakhstan (8.4%) regions.

Paid services in the country rose in price by 6.4%, while it increased much higher in West Kazakhstan (7.7%), Zhambyl (7.5%), East Kazakhstan (7.4%), Turkistan (7.2%), Mangystau (7.1%) regions and Shymkent city (6.8%).

In November 2021 monthly inflation amounted to 0.7%, which is lower than last 5 years' mean (2016-2020 years). Growth above its historical level was noted only in East Kazakhstan and Akmola regions (1.2% and 1.1%, respectively). In other regions growth was about their mean or lower. Significant slowdown in the monthly level was observed in Turkistan (0.3%), Karagandy (0.6%), Atyrau (0.3%) regions and Nur-Sultan city (0.9%), where inflation was considerably higher in November. Prices in these regions over the last 5 years increased in average by 0.9%, 1.1%, 0.7% and 1.3%, respectively.
