




# Inflation trends in the regions

February 2023

Annual inflation in February 2023 amounted to 21.3% (in January - 20.7%). Prices for food products over the year increased by 26.2% (in January - 25.7%), for non-food products - by 20.5% (in January - 20.2%), for paid services - by 15.0% (in January - 14.2%).

By regions annual inflation accelerated in 17 regions, and slowed down in 3 regions. Annual inflation turned out to be higher than the national level in 9 regions. The highest values of annual inflation were recorded in Mangystau region (25.1%), Astana city (23.5%) and Akmola region (22.4%).

**Food** products in Kazakhstan rose in price above the national level (26.2% YoY) in Mangystau region (32.1%), Shymkent city (28.6%), Turkistan (27.9%), Kyzylorda (27. 0%), North Kazakhstan (26.9%), Astana city (26.5%), Zhambyl and Pavlodar (26.4% each), Aktobe and Kostanay (26.3% each) regions.

Prices for **non-food** products are higher than in the country (20.5% YoY) increased in Astana city (31.3%), East Kazakhstan (22.5%), North Kazakhstan (21.4%), Turkistan (21.0%), Zhetysu (20.7%) and Abai (20.6%) regions.

Prices for **paid services** increased by 15.0% YoY, while the growth was above the national level in Akmola (20.2%), Mangystau (19.9%), Ulytau (18.5%), Pavlodar (17. 1%), Aktobe and Almaty city (16.9% each), Kostanay (16.6%), Karaganda (16.3%), North Kazakhstan (15.7%) and West Kazakhstan (15.3%) regions.

In February 2023 monthly inflation in the country amounted to 1.3%, which is significantly higher than the average February inflation over the past 5 years (0.6% for 2018-2022). In all regions, with the exception of the Kyzylorda region, prices in February 2023 rose above the historical average. The highest value of monthly inflation was noted in Almaty region (1.8%).
