

Number of respondents in August 2021 - 462 enterprises




- The business activity index is a composite indicator that includes the aggregate of enterprises' answers to questions regarding the actual changes in the economic indicators of enterprises and the expectations regarding their changes in the future.
- The National Bank of Kazakhstan conducts a survey of enterprises participating in the monitoring of the real sector on a monthly basis



# ENTERPRISES-RESPONDENTS BY SECTOR





### CONSOLIDATED BUSINESS ACTIVITY INDEX (BAI) BY ECONOMY



According to the results of a monthly survey of 462 enterprises in the real sector in August 2021 the business activity index decreased by 0,6 points, amounting to **50,2** (in July – 50,8).

In the service sector the index formed at **50,7**, in industry – **49,1**, in construction – **51,9** (in July – 51,1, 50,5, 50,1, respectively).

\*\* A value of the indicator above level 50 means a positive change, below level 50 - a negative The further (higher or lower) the index value is from the 50 level, the higher the rate of change (increase or decrease) of the indicator.

The consolidated business activity index by the economy is an aggregate index for three sectors of the economy, weighted by the contribution to GVA



### **BUSINESS ACTIVITY INDEX (BAI) BY SECTOR**



\* A value of the indicator above the 50 level means a positive change, below the 50 level - a negative one. The further (higher or lower) the value of the index from the level 50, the higher the rate of change (increase or decrease) of the indicator.


The growth of business activity is observed in **construction**, where the index increased by 1,8 points, amounting to **51,9**. The improvement of the index in construction was influenced by an increase in employment rate.

In the **service** and **industry** sectors, the indices were **50,7** and **49,1**, falling by 0,4 and 1,4 points, respectively. The deterioration of the index in the service sector is related with a decrease in employment rate, and in industry – due to a reduction in the volume of new orders, new products and employment rate, as well as an increase in delivery times.




#### **BUSINESS ACTIVITY INDEX BY REGIONS**

#### **BAI dynamics for July - August 2021**




In the context of the regions, an improvement in the business activity was observed in 9 regions of Kazakhstan: Turkestan (54,6), Shymkent city (52,8), Karaganda (52,3), Almaty (52,3) regions, Nur-Sultan city (51,6), Zhambyl (51,6), Kostanay (50,9), North Kazakhstan (50,6) and East Kazakhstan (50,6) regions.

The deterioration of the business activity was observed in 8 regions of Kazakhstan: Aktobe (43,2), Kyzylorda (45,9), Mangystau (47,7) regions, Almaty city (48,1), Pavlodar (48,1), Atyrau (49,6), West Kazakhstan (49,8) and Akmola (49,8) regions.



PMI BY COUNTRY


# DYNAMICS OF COMPOSITE PMI BY COUNTRIES, MAJOR TRADING PARTNERS OF KAZAKHSTAN



Industry PMI for Turkey and the Netherlands





# BUSINESS CLIMATE INDEX (BCI) Current situation assessment



\*Balance of answers (BA) is difference between positive and negative answers. Enterprises asked to assess the current business situation choosing one of the given answers «favorable», «unfavorable» and «neutral». Answers are weighted by respondents' size.

If index is above 0 improvement, if below 0 – worsening.




According to respondents, in August 2021 the **current business conditions improved** compared to July. The balance of answers\* increased from **0,5** to **1,7** due to some softening of quarantine measures in the country.

The indicator in industry was 1,9, in construction – 6,1, in service sector – 0,9.

Respondents positively assessed the demand for products/services (4,3), access to finance/loans (4,1) and access to communications (3,5). The assessment of the current business conditions was negatively affected by tax burden (-2,5) and business protection issues (-2,1), which were negatively assessed by enterprises in all sectors.

In August 2021 according to the respondents the balance of answers of assessing the current business conditions was 1,7 (in July - 0,5). The current conditions were assessed worse than in April-June by enterprises, but better than in July of this year. The balance of answers on expectations for the next 6 months was 17,6 (in July - 21,1). Despite a slight decrease in optimism in August, the economy of Kazakhstan remained in the area of **boom** of business cycle "clock".

The **business climate index** which is an average assessment of current and future business conditions worsened in the economy, amounting to 9,5 (in July -10,5). The decrease in the BCI is related with a decrease in optimism in the assessment of future (from 21,1 to 17,6). In business conditions construction and industry, BCIs were 11,8 and 10,0, respectively. The indicator in service sector turned out to be lower than in the economy (9,5), amounting to 8,8.



#### METHODOLOGICAL COMMENT

- ✓ The information was prepared based on the results of monthly surveys of enterprises participating in the monitoring of the real sector.
- ✓ To calculate the Business Activity Index, the diffusion index (DI) is used, which is calculated as the sum of positive responses and half of the responses unchanged. This index is a generalized indicator characterizing the dynamics of changes in the indicator.
- ✓ The data on the diagram are presented with the elimination of the seasonality factor.
- ✓ Changes are possible in the previous months dynamics due to seasonal clearing and GVA adjustment.
- ✓ The Business Climate Index and Business Cycle Clock are constructed using the methodology of Ifo institute, Germany.
